**COST ALLOCATION
METHODOLOGY:**

Costs associated with this BE/OCA combination are directly charged to Florida's State Opioid Response (SOR) Grant.

**BUDGET
RESTRICTIONS:**

Funds may not be used by any provider that denies any eligible individual access to their program because of their use of FDA-approved medications for the treatment of substance use disorders, namely methadone and buprenorphine. In all cases, MAT must be permitted to be continued for as long as the prescriber determines that the medication is clinically beneficial. Providers must assure that individuals will not be compelled to no longer use MAT as part of the conditions of any programming if stopping is inconsistent with a licensed prescriber's recommendation or valid prescription. In addition, State Opioid Response funds may not be used for the following purposes:

- o Make direct payments to individuals to enter treatment or continue to participate in prevention or treatment services.
- o To pay for construction or purchase of structures.
- o To pay the salary of an individual at a rate in excess of \$189,600.
- o To supplant (or replace) current funding of existing services.
