

Non-Custodial Parents

- Must have court order to pay child support
- Children must live in Florida
- Non-custodial and custodial parent must have income below 200% of poverty level
- Income of custodial parent must be obtained.
 If not available, then alternative funding must be pursued.

Eligible for TANF services?

ME Provider enters client in DCF TANF database and notifies CFCHS

TANF Database CFCHS approves client in database

ME provider records TANF confirmation # in client file

TANF Treatment Plan Goals:

- (1) Children can be cared for in their own homes or in the homes of relatives; and
- (2) Families can be self-sufficient.

ME Provider provides services and verifies income on a monthly basis

ME Provider submits data and Participant Log by 10th of month

Discharge:

ME Provider discharges client from DCF TANF database

If TANF eligibility cannot be determined; route to other funding streams
