PURPOSE:

This Budget Entity/Other Cost Accumulator (BE/OCA) combination captures the allowable costs of behavioral health services for individuals who are indigent, uninsured, or underinsured and experiencing behavioral health effects as a result of COVID-19 through the Emergency Grants to Address Mental Health and Substance Use Disorders During COVID-19. All covered services described in ch. 65E-14.021, F.A.C., are allowable except Prevention-Indicated; Prevention-Selective; Prevention-Universal Direct; Prevention-Universal Indirect; and Inpatient. IMPOWER, a telehealth provider under contract with Central Florida Cares Health System, may provide services via telehealth for healthcare practitioners and others requiring mental health care as result of COVID-19. They may use \$45,000 of grant funds to enhance their telehealth platform, strategically message the availability of services, and for other grant implementation costs. Managing Entities may enhance their existing service array, including telehealth, to serve individuals with serious emotional disturbance, serious mental illness, and substance use disorders whose symptoms are exacerbated due to COVID-19.

**COST ALLOCATION
METHODOLOGY:**

Costs associated with this BE/OCA combination are directly charged to Florida's Emergency Grant to Address Mental and Substance Use Disorders During COVID-19.

**BUDGET
RESTRICTIONS:**

These funds may not be used for the following purposes:

- o make direct payments to individuals to enter treatment or continue to participate in prevention or treatment services;
- o to pay for construction or purchase of structures
- o to pay the salary of an individual at a rate in excess of \$189,000
- o to supplant (or replace) current funding of existing services
- o directly or indirectly, purchase, prescribe, or provide marijuana or treatment using marijuana
- o to pay for client expenses such as utilities, rent, phones, or food.
