PURPOSE:

BE/OCA combination captures allowable costs of medication-assisted treatment (MAT) services for the treatment of opioid use disorder associated with the State Targeted Response to the Opioid Crisis Grant awarded by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) as a two year discretionary grant.

Eligibility includes individuals who are indigent, uninsured, or underinsured and have an opioid use disorder, including use of illicit drugs, such as heroin, or prescription opioids. The following individuals who misuse opioids should be prioritized:

1. Pregnant women who are injecting opioids
2. Pregnant women
3. Caretakers involved with child welfare
4. Caretakers of children ages 0-5
5. Individuals re-entering the community from incarceration

Funds may be used to pay for methadone or buprenorphine maintenance treatment. The following covered services described in ch. 65E-14.021, F.A.C., are allowable uses of these funds when provided to individuals in conjunction with methadone or buprenorphine maintenance treatment:

1. Aftercare
2. Assessment
3. Case Management
4. Daycare
5. Day Treatment
6. Incidental Expenses
7. In-Home and On-Site
8. Medical Services
9. Medication-Assisted Treatment
10. Outpatient
11. Outreach
12. Recovery Support
13. Substance Abuse Outpatient Detoxification
14. Supported Employment
15. Supportive Housing/Living
16. Crisis Support/Emergency

SOURCE OF MATCH: This BE/OCA combination is 100% funded by the Federal Government; therefore, no match is required.

**COST ALLOCATION
METHODOLOGY:**

Costs associated with this BE/OCA combination are directly charged State Targeted Response (STR) to the Opioid Crisis Grant.

BUDGET RESTRICTIONS:

Only five percent of the total grant award is permitted to be used for administrative and infrastructure costs to administer the grant. At least 80 percent of the remaining grant award must be spent on opioid use disorder treatment Mbd or subawarded to any agency which would deny any eligible client, patient, or individual access to their program because of their use of FDA-approved medications for the treatment of substance use disorders. Funds may not be used to supplant existing opioid prevention, treatment, and recovery activities.

SOURCE OF FUNDS:

This BE/OCA combination is funded through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, State Targeted Response to the Opioid Crisis Grant.
