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Collaborative Assessment and Management of Suicidality (CAMS) is one of only 3 evidence-based treatments for suicidality and is endorsed as a best practice by our major suicide prevention organizations and accrediting bodies; including the Zero Suicide Institute, Suicide Prevention Resource Center, SAMHSA, Joint Commission, and CARF.

Clinicians completing the following 4-stage curriculum earn the CAMS-Trained designation from CAMS-care. The 4 stages include:

- (1) CAMS BOOK REVIEW, 8-10 hours
- (2) CAMS ONLINE COURSE, 3 hours
- (3) CAMS ONLINE ROLE PLAY, 7 hours
- (4) CAMS CONSULTATION CALLS (4 x 1 hour)

CAMS designation costs \$359 per person; however, CAMS will be provided **FREE** to you and paid by Central Florida Cares if curriculum completions are met.
