SUBJECT: Amendment #2 to Purchase Agreement No. OCG25
between Central Florida Cares Health System, Inc. and
Orange County Government for Coordinated Opioid
Recovery Program (CORe)

On April 9, 2024, the Board approved an agreement between Central Florida Cares Health System, Inc., and Orange County Government in the amount of \$1,000,000. This funding is being used to increase access to medication for opioid use disorder, mental health treatment, and social support for individuals with substance use and mental health disorders. The funding period is from April 1, 2024, through April 1, 2025.

Attached is amendment #2 for your review and signature. This amendment will extend the end date to June 30, 2026, and increase the contract amount by \$500,000 to a total of \$1.5M. Additionally, I've included the original agenda item, which gives the Mayor or designee permission to sign amendments to this agreement. This amendment was reviewed by the County Attorney's Office.

THIS AMENDMENT, entered into between **Central Florida Cares Health System, Inc.**, hereinafter referred to as "CFCHS" and **Orange County, Florida** hereinafter referred to as the "Subcontractor," amends **Purchase Agreement No. OCG25**, hereafter identified as **OCG26**.

The purpose of this amendment is to extend the term of the agreement, incorporate a renewal clause, update the agreement number, and update the funding and budget.

1. Page 1 is hereby amended to read (words underlined are inserted and words stricken are deleted):

2. Page 4 is hereby amended to read (words underlined are inserted and words stricken are deleted).

5. Method of Payment

- a. This is a fixed price Agreement. CFCHS shall pay the County in accordance with the conditions of this Agreement, a prorated amount each month, for a total amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00 \$1,500,000.00 for FY24-25 and FY 25-26, subject to the availability of funds. The Department of Children and Families allocated \$1,000,000.00 for FY23-24, and the parties acknowledge that the unspent funds from FY23-24 are being carried over to fund FY24-25. The parties expect that any unspent funds from FY24-25 will be carried over to FY 25-26, subject to availability of funding.

3. Page 9 is hereby amended to read (words underlined are inserted and words stricken are deleted):

9. Renewals

Upon mutual agreement, the Company and the County may renew this Agreement, in whole or in part, for a period that may not exceed 3 years or the original term of the Agreement, whichever period is longer. Renewals must be in writing and signed by both parties and are contingent upon satisfactory performance evaluations and subject to availability of funds.

9--10. Term and Termination

This Agreement shall begin on **April 1, 2024**, and will continue in effect until **June 30, 2026**, ~~April 1, 2025~~.

4. Page 17, Exhibit B – Health Services Division Budget (Rv 1), as added by Amendment #1, is hereby replaced with the Health Services Division Budget attached to this Amendment as Exhibit B (Rv 2).

This Amendment shall become effective on **July 1, 2024**, or the date in which the amendment has been signed by both parties, whichever is earlier.

All provisions in the Agreement and any attachments thereto in conflict with this Amendment shall be and are hereby changed to conform to this Amendment.


All provisions not in conflict with this Amendment are still in effect and are to be performed at the level specified in the Agreement.


