
- Ability Housing, Inc. - The recommendation is to exercise the contract renewal clause and renew this contract for three (3) years.

- Central Florida Treatment Centers - The recommendation is to propose a new four (4) year contract.
- Clear Futures - The recommendation is to exercise the contract renewal clause and renew this contract for one (1) year.
- Community Assisted and Supportive Living - The recommendation is to propose a new four (4) year contract.
- Eckerd Connects - The recommendation is to exercise the contract renewal clause and renew this contract for five (5) years.


- Gulf Coast Jewish Family and Community Services - The recommendation is to exercise the contract renewal clause and renew this contract for three (3) years.
